- 2. An explanation of how this will improve clinical practice in the field.
- 3. Study design details (including sample size, inclusion/exclusion criteria, duration and timetable/milestone).
- 4. An explanation of why the project has scientific value, is innovative and would benefit from the Fund.
- 5. Budget and funding amount requested.
- 6. CV of applicant(s) including any history of research experience.

Vitaflo will acknowledge receipt of every application received and will provide feedback to unsuccessful applicants on request.

A panel consisting of Vitaflo employees with experience in the relevant field will evaluate each application that meets the criteria above. Successful applicants will be determined by simple majority vote and the Panel's decision is final.

Who can apply and how?

All professionals working in the fields of inborn errors of metabolism, ketogenic diet or paediatric renal disease are invited to apply to the Fund. The Panel will give priority to applications related to dietary management and we particularly welcome applications from new researchers.
